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**Challenges of Manuscript Descriptions  
in the Modern Libraries' Information Landscape**

**Content and Objectives of the Lecture and Group Work on the Lecture Topic:**

The lecture intends to give an overview of the kinds of existing (mostly traditional) manuscript descriptions (with some examples) and possibilities to make best use of them in a database and on the internet. For this some databases (both generic mss databases and union catalogue systems) will be analysed in their contents and structures. The possibilities of interlinking of records, portals, the use of authority files and finally semantic web structures will be presented. Some particular issues of mss cataloguing will be considered (e.g. authorship, text and illumination, research surveys). Some databases for particular features of the mss such as ones on bindings, watermarks, etc. will be presented to discuss how they can be integrated. The lecture will focus on codex descriptions – but the challenges of archival material and its particular structures will at least be touched upon.

Objectives are to give awareness of the possibilities to integrate existing material into the modern internet architectures and to present descriptions on different levels to different audiences.

**Assignment:**

For an assignment to this topic the student should have a good understanding of data structures. A survey about existing mss databases and the comparative discussion of their structures with a guideline for harmonization would be welcome.
